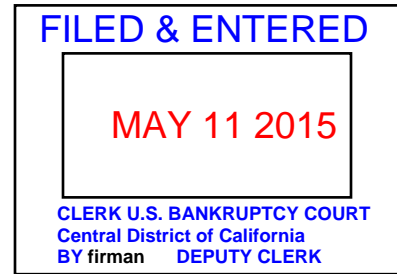

22 A continued hearing was held on May 7, 2015, at 1:30 p.m., before the Honorable
23 Catherine E. Bauer, United States Bankruptcy Judge for the Central District of California, in
24 Courtroom 5D located at 411 West Fourth St., Santa Ana, CA, on Creditors' Motion for
25 Sanctions Pursuant to Federal Bankruptcy Rule 9011 filed February 19, 2015 as Docket #34
26 ("Motion"). Appearances were made as follows:

2 of Bryan Schwartz Law (“Schwartz Law”) appeared on behalf of Creditors (who are Amanda

4 Perkins and Kellianne Ryan) and Stephen Madoni appeared on behalf of the Debtor.

5 The Court having read and considered the Motion, the related pleadings, heard the
6 statements of counsel and with good cause shown,

7 IT IS ORDERED:

- 8 1. The Motion is granted against the Debtor only.
9 2. The Motion is denied as to Debtor’s counsel, James Cover and Coverlaw PC.
10 3. Creditors are awarded sanctions in the following amounts (collectively the

11 “Sanctions Amount”):


12 a. For services rendered by LNBYB: fees of \$40,430.00 and costs of
13 \$1,768.28 for a total of \$42,198.28.

14 b. For services rendered by Schwartz Law: fees of \$9,843.75 and costs of
15 \$75.50 for a total fees of \$9,919.25.

16 5. The Sanctions Amount shall be paid to LNBYB for deposit in its client trust
17 account no later than 14 business days following the entry of this Order. (
